

Standing Regulations

DISCLAIMER:

Motorsport is dangerous, while every effort is made to reduce the consequences of participation in the event, however due to driver skill error, misjudgement or mechanical failure of a vehicle, events beyond the control of the organisers can occur. All participants will be required and agree to sign an indemnity form on the day of the event. No form= No entry on the day.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

At no time may any vehicle be driven unnecessarily erratically or in a manner which could be deemed potentially dangerous to any other person or property. This will apply anywhere on the venue. Failure of a participant to respect this rule may lead to disqualification from any further participation on the day. The imposition of this penalty will be at the discretion of the event organisers and Clerk of the Course.

PARTICIPATION:

Participation is open to anyone who is a registered entrant for the HTA 25 event and has registered for the motorsport activity to enter, or who pays the necessary entry fee on the day, provided they are a registered for the HTA 25 event. **No non HTA 25 participant** entries will be accepted on the day. So please don't tell your mates to bring their cars down to 'have a go' they will not be allowed on the track.

VEHICLES:

Participation is open to anyone driving a XA, XB, XC, or Landau Ford Falcon Hardtop, of any model. Cars can be shared between drivers, provided the other drivers have all paid their entry fees and signed the necessary disclaimer forms.

Vehicles entered must comply with the following.

- Be of a model type suitable for entry in the HTA 25 event.
- Be of good mechanical condition and considered roadworthy by the clerk of course.
- Boots must be empty, with all loose items removed, spare wheels removed and any non-secured mats and alike removed.
- Cabins must be free from loose objects, centre consoles empty and gloveboxes emptied.
- Floor mats should be removed, unless secured.
- Batteries must be securely held with approved battery clamps and similar devices.
- Road tyres only should be used, slick tyres only to be allowed at discretion of clerk of course.
- Driver seat belt must be in good condition and always worn.
- Driver seat shall be secure and in good condition.

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Optional, but recommended

- That vehicles be fitted with a 1kg fire extinguisher. If fitted these should be within reach of the driver from the driver seat.
- Vehicles, especially those with manual transmissions should be fitted with tail shaft loops for driver safety and prevention of catastrophic vehicle damage.
- Go Pro and any other filming device must be secured within the vehicle, secondary restraints for the device are encouraged.

Please note, participation in the organised driving events, may place additional stresses on the vehicles drive train, suspension and braking system, then would normally be experienced in road use, depending on how you drive. Please ensure your vehicle is well maintained and up to the task. Vehicle breakdown can be dangerous, result in expensive repairs and reduces the available track time for all participants.

APPAREL

Participants must.

- Wear an approved helmet, either of their own supply or borrowed from organisers. Open faced helmets are fine
- Drivers must wear long sleeves, long pants and enclosed footwear with socks.
- Drivers are encouraged to wear gloves.
- Wearing glasses and sunglasses are of course acceptable.

TIMING DEVICES

The event is designated a driving skill and vehicle capability event, therefore there will be no timing of participants permitted.

EVENT CONTENT

The driving activity on the day will be established guided by an experienced driving event organiser. All participants will be required to attend a drivers briefing before the event starts. Further details will be provided closer to the event date.

FURTHER SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Event organisers reserve the rights to update these regulations with additional requirements subject to the needs of Motorsport Australia and the Clerk of Course. Entrants will be notified should this occur closer to the event timing.
